

Ministry Impact!

Camp Lutherhaven Fact Sheet

What is it?

A Ministry Impact position is an opportunity for a person 18 years and over to work at Camp Lutherhaven for a period of about nine months. Under the supervision of Lutherhaven's leaders, this person would work about the equivalent of 3 days per week at Camp Lutherhaven. The nine month contract would be roughly from September through May. Lutherhaven encourages and will assist the worker in finding other part-time work or schooling as available. A Ministry Impact position can be a great vocational opportunity while being a valuable asset to the unique outdoor ministry of Camp Lutherhaven.

What kind of things would I do for Camp Lutherhaven?

The ministry impact worker would be involved in a number of camp ministries and tasks such as assisting in confirmation, outdoor education school groups, and other retreat programming and hosting, traveling to churches and schools to assist in camp publicity, working in the office and kitchen, and performing maintenance and housekeeping as needed. By its very nature, Camp Lutherhaven has a broad range of ministry areas and tasks. Opportunities also are available for workers to complete tasks based on the talents and skill they bring to the position. (see full job description)

What does it pay?

A Ministry Impact worker will receive:

Monthly Salary of \$543 for a nine month period, with a gross total of \$4887

Housing, food stipend and utilities provided

Mileage reimbursement when a personal vehicle is used for Camp purposes

Time off to be coordinated with Lutherhaven and the worker's schedule

Where will I live?

The Ministry Impact worker will live in an onsite facility at Camp Lutherhaven (tan or medic cabin), with access to bathroom, shower and kitchen facilities. The worker will be in charge of preparing his/her own food, while also having access to many meals prepared when Camp is cooking for another group.

What about necessary training and equipping?

Staff members Keith Peters, Director of Summer and Youth Ministry, and Tim Jank, Executive Director, will train, coordinate with, and coach the Ministry Impact worker as needed to enhance the mission and ministry programs of Camp Lutherhaven.
